Sunday Kids Notes

Print these notes out for your kids to use while listening to Sunday worship. Encourage them to take notes, write down the verses from what we are studying, and questions they have to ask after worship is over.

You will notice there is an elementary one which provides more spaces to write and a preschool one which provides more room to draw.

Bible Bingo

As the pastor preaches use the bingo card with your kids to help them listen to the sermon. As they hear a word they can color in the boxes, encourage them to color in as many as they hear.

You will notice there is a preschool (less words and repetitive) and elementary (more words) version. Both of the version will go along with the scripture being preached on that given morning.
